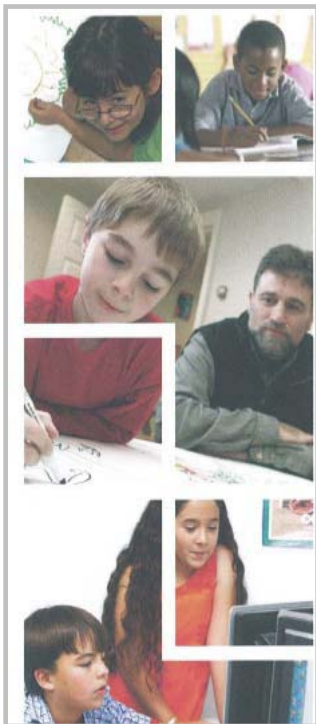




Lesley University celebrates its first 100 years!
